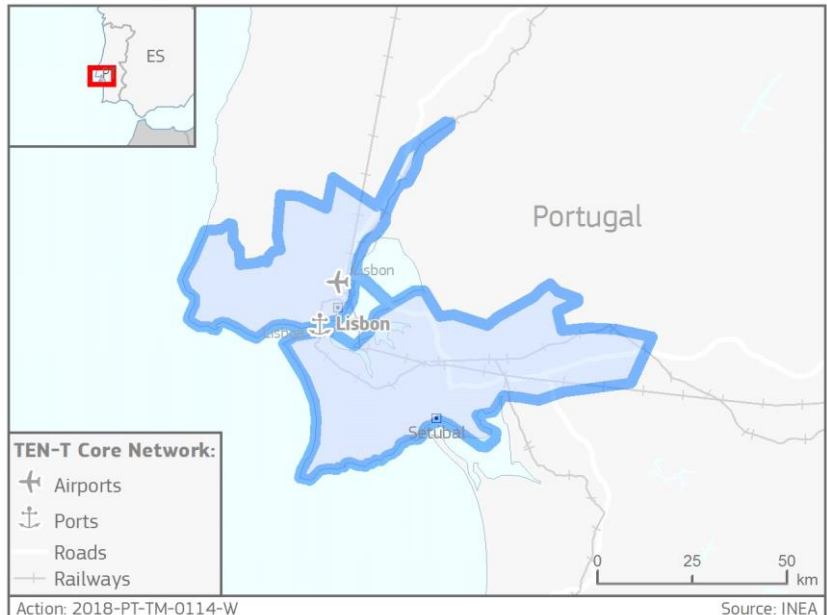

The Action aims to promote and introduce a new multimodal and mobile ticketing platform common to all mobility operators and all travellers in the Lisbon Metropolitan Area (AML). The purpose of the Action is to deploy a new central ticketing system by harmonising different systems towards a unique, innovative and inclusive one, to incorporate technological developments and upgrades of existing systems to support mobile tickets and bank cards, and to strengthen multimodal ticketing delivery. The Project contributes to the TEN-T Core Network since AML contains core nodes, Lisbon and Setúbal, located on the Atlantic Corridor of the TEN-T network.

### Evaluation Remarks

The relevance of the Action is excellent. It addresses the call objectives on innovation and new technologies and demonstrates its European added value. The maturity is very good.
